I am writing in response to your letter to me dated July 20, 2016 asking me to provide an update regarding the appellants' position that a transcript does not need to be ordered. 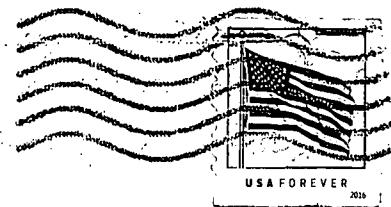
