Dear Judge Hughston,

I am in receipt of the Defendant's Motion to Reconsider his Sentence of May 30, 2016.

Mr. Mungin pleaded guilty to Burglary Second Degree (Violent), Domestic Violence in the Second Degree, and a Property Offense Enhancement. The Burglary charge was reduced from a Burglary in the First Degree. The State also dismissed a Criminal Domestic Violence of a High and Aggravated Nature charge involving the same victim as the Domestic Violence Second Degree charge to which the Defendant pleaded in consideration of the guilty plea.

On the Burglary Second Degree (Violent) charge, Your Honor sentenced Mr. Mungin to ten years in prison suspended upon the service of five years followed by five years' probation. He was also sentenced to five years on the Property Offense Enhancement charge and one year on the Domestic Violence Second Degree charge. The Defendant filed his Motion to Reconsider the Sentences on June 8, 2016.





events transpired and why she made the false accusations in the first place. She indicated that the alleged domestic violence incident did not happen and that Mr. Mungin was merely catching her from falling into a table. She also stated that her landlord, a potential witness, had a financial bias because Mr. Mungin wanted to move Ms. Butler out of that house that she was renting.

6. If the domestic violence incident did not occur, then there is no burglary based on the element requiring intent to commit a crime therein.
7. The property crime enhancement is based on Mr. Mungin allegedly pawning an item that did not belong to him and receiving cash from the pawn shop. Mr. Mungin asserts that he traded for the item and did not know that he was not in rightful possession when he pawned it.

Based on the foregoing, the Defendant respectfully requests that this Court reconsider the sentence imposed in the above-referenced case. Specifically, the Defendant requests that this Court impose an active sentence of 3 years for Mr. Mungin, with the balance suspended to probation.
