MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI AND
ACCOMPANYING APPENDIX

Counsel for Oblin Banegas-Maldonado respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until September 9, 2016**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix is due to be served and filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Oblin Banegas-Maldonado respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed a petition for rehearing in the case of The State of South Carolina v. William Anthony Wallace on July 14, 2016 with the Court of Appeals. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Darrella Watson v. The State of South Carolina on July 8, 2016 with this Court. Counsel filed a petition for rehearing in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Marco Sanders on July 7, 2016 with the Court of Appeals.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request as shown by signature below.


