## ORDER

Appellant has filed a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* and a "motion for order to waive transcripts and fees and cost." These motions are denied pursuant to *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order. Appellant's motions requesting an extension of time to order the transcript and to serve and file Appellant's initial brief are both granted. Within ten days of the date of this order, Appellant shall provide proof showing he has ordered the transcript and made satisfactory arrangements regarding payment of the transcript pursuant to Rule 207, SCACR.
