At a Court of General Sessions, convened on **AUG 25 2015** the Grand Jurors of Greenville

County present upon their oath:


COUNT I – ARMED ROBBERY

That CHARLES THOMPSON did in Greenville County, on or about the 1st day of February, 2015, while armed with a deadly weapon, or while alleging either by action or words he was armed while using a representation of a deadly weapon or any object which a person present during the commission of the robbery would reasonably believe to be a deadly weapon, take by means of force or intimidation, goods or monies described as: 20 electric tooth brushes from PUBLIX. This is in violation of §16-11-330 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.

COUNT II – POSSESSION OF A WEAPON DURING THE COMMISSION OF A VIOLENT CRIME

That CHARLES THOMPSON did in Greenville County on or about the 1st day of February, 2015 possess or visibly display a knife during the commission or attempted commission of a violent crime, to wit: Armed Robbery. This is in violation of §16-23-490 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.
