ORDER

Respondent has filed a motion to require Appellant to amend the record on appeal to include two matters that were designated by Respondent but omitted from the record. Within twenty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve a supplemental record on appeal that includes the two matters omitted from the record. Specifically, the supplemental record on appeal shall include only: (1) the Judgement filed in the Surfside Magistrate's Court on February 14, 2014; and (2) the Summary of Testimony of Trial by the Honorable G. Derek Blanton. Within twenty days, Appellant shall also file with this court a proof of service showing the supplemental record on appeal was served on Respondent. Respondent's request for an award of the costs incurred in filing the motion is denied.
