It is my understanding that you were the court reporter at this time. That being the case, I request that you send this office the original trial transcript along with your bill. If you are aware of the existence of co-defendants not listed in the prior captioned case, please contact us prior to transcribing the transcript. In this manner, we can consult our records to ensure that in ordering a transcript, a duplication has not occurred. In addition, if the Attorney General's Office has already requested an original transcript, please notify us.


