## ORDER

On June 8, 2016, this court filed an unpublished opinion affirming Appellant's conviction and sentence. On June 23, 2016, Appellant petitioned for a rehearing of the appeal and sought reconsideration of this court's opinion. The parties have now filed a joint motion for approval of a settlement, asking this court to remand the case to the municipal court and stay the deadline for Respondent's return to Appellant's petition for rehearing. The motion is granted. This case is remanded in part to the municipal court for consideration of the parties' settlement agreement. Within ten days of entry of this order, counsel for Respondent shall contact counsel for Appellant and the municipal court to schedule such hearings as the municipal court judge deems appropriate. Counsel for Respondent shall provide updates to the clerk of this court within fifteen days of the date of this order and every thirty days thereafter, with a copy to counsel for Appellant. This appeal will be held in abeyance pending the municipal court's resolution of this matter.
