
MOTION TO REQUEST EXTENSION



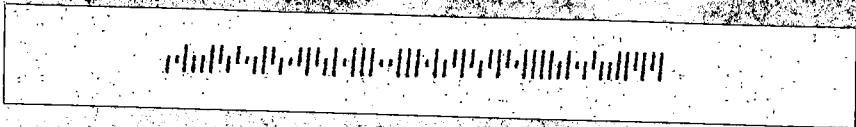
