MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Freddie Richard Jones respectfully requests an extension of a **final** thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix is due to be served and filed with the Court today, May 9, 2012.
2. Counsel for Mr. Jones respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



On April 18, 2012 counsel filed the petitions for writ of certiorari and appendices in Antwan Wade v. State and Stacy Evans v. State in the Supreme Court. On April 6, 2012 counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in Ricky Dale Gilstrap v. State in the Supreme Court.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


