Upon reviewing your record on appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The document is improperly paginated. Specifically, each page must have a different and sequential number. For example, you have all 20 pages of the transcript numbered page 7.
- The index is incorrect due to the pagination being incorrect.
- The certificate of counsel provided is not the correct certificate of counsel for the record on appeal. Pursuant to Rule 210(g), SCACR, the certificate of counsel for the record on appeal must certify that the Record on Appeal contains all material proposed to be included by any of the parties and not any other material.
