
filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Phillip Joseph Stegall in this Court on June 15, 2016.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay.


4. As indicated by consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


