Concurrently with the filing of this letter and six copies for the court, is the filing of the Joint Amended Record. This Joint Amended Record was facilitated by Ms. Ballard supplying documents Appellants had been asking for on August 18, 2016. The Appellants, in an effort to avoid further delays, have ignored the addition of documents by Ms. Ballard that were not in her designations. However, the Appellants maintain their objection to the inclusion of the "expert report" by Mara Ballard (ROA pgs. 225-370) as all discovery required under Rule 26 was denied by the Court rendering this document as inadmissible hearsay.

Appellants cannot locate "the Form 4 order dated December 30, 2014" requested by Ms. Ballard. The Clerk of Court's Office does not have a record of its existence, as the case disposition date was 12/23/2014. As you know, Appellants have requested a copy of this letter from Ms. Ballard, Ms. Ballard has not responded in any manner to Appellants multiple request for assistance on this document. Therefore, we have to move forward as further delay is unwarranted and Ms. Ballard can file this document if she locates it as a supplement.


Respondent wanted documents with stray markings a natural occurrence over the years and highlighting on the original filings by the Appellants removed as Ms. Desa

Ballard claimed it made it hard to read. Appellant has been able to make more readable documents submitted by the Appellants by removing highlighting, which was on the original filed documents, where it could conceivably cause a greater effort to read. However, the documents originally filed with markings for emphasis (i.e. boxed in areas) were left as originally filed with the Court. Furthermore, Ms. Desa Ballard asked for Appellants to edit her documents she submitted to the Court, mainly the "expert report" by Mara Ballard, (See ROA pages 234, 235, 243, 251, 252, 254, 263, 308, 321, 322, 349, 350, 351, 352, 353, 359, 360, 361). The Appellants were not able to change those filings, as it would be editing Respondents filings that is against the rules.


Appellants have enclosed the original and six copies of this letter.
