Appellant has filed a motion for a bond pending appeal. Appellant has also filed a motion for bond in the circuit court, and it appears that the motion is still pending. Because the sentence is less than ten years, Rule 246 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules permits the circuit court to consider bond. Accordingly, this court finds the matter more appropriate for the circuit court's consideration, and we decline to consider Appellant's motion.
