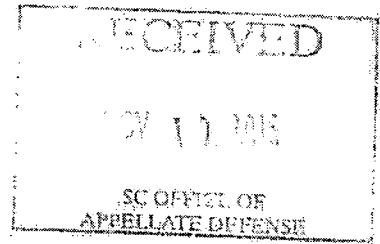

ORDER
