MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE
INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Randy Glenn, respectfully requests a **fourth and final** thirty (30) **until September 30, 2016**, days in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Randy Glenn, respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of

extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Austin McQuarters on August 10, 2016 with this court. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Robert Wilson on July 26, 2016 with this Court. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of Willis Weary v. The State of South Carolina on July 25, 2016 with the Supreme Court.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.




