ORDER

Appellant appeals the family court's order denying Appellant's motion for protection, which sought to prevent Respondent's litigation counsel from speaking with and representing physicians and medical personnel employed by Respondent prior to their scheduled depositions in the underlying case. Respondent filed a motion to dismiss the appeal, and Appellant filed a return. After careful consideration, Respondents' motion to dismiss is granted because the underlying order is not immediately appealable pursuant to section 14-3-330 (1976 & Supp. 2015).
