DEAR HONORABLE JENNY A. KITCHINGS,

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT THIS LETTER AND OR REQUEST IS BEING SUBMITTED ON THE ABOVE DATE IN GOOD-FAITH, WITH ALL DUE RESPECT.

PLEASE BE FURTHER ADVISED THAT I, EDWARD L. DEAN, HEREBY STATE THE FOLLOWING FACT(S) THAT I WAS WRONGFULLY CONVICTED MACH 5<sup>TH</sup> 2014, AND SENTENCED TO TWENTY-FIVE (25) YEARS FOR 1<sup>ST</sup> DEGREE BURGLARY ETC. APRIL 13<sup>TH</sup> 2016, JUDGE ADDY CONVENED A HEARING AND MAY 4<sup>TH</sup> 2016 BY WRITTEN ORDER - GRANTED MR. DEAN A NEW TRIAL DUE TO PROSECUTORIAL MISCONDUCT. THE PROSECUTION, LAW ENFORCEMENT, ATTORNEY STEPHEN GEOLY, ALONG WITH FALSE-BIAS TESTIMONY OF ADRIAN GASTON, DID DECEIVE / MISLEAD MR. DEAN, THE COURT AND JURY BY CONCEALING ITS DEAL FOR PROBATION IT HAD WITH ADRIAN GASTON, AND THEY WOULD CONVEY TO THE COURT HIS COOPERATION AND TESTIMONY IN THE DEAN'S TRIAL.

THE PROSECUTION HAS APPEALED THE ORDER OF JUDGE ADDY GRANTING MR. DEAN A NEW TRIAL TO OBTAIN TRANSCRIPTS TO "PROVE" SOLICITOR SHANNON S. ODOM STATED ON RECORD THAT GASTON WAS TOLD THAT HIS COOPERATION WOULD BE CONSIDERED AND TAKING INTO ACCOUNT WHEN HIS CHARGES WERE DEALT WITH AT A LATER DATE. THIS WOULD MEAN-IF SHE STATED THIS ON THE RECORD, SHE CLEARLY ADMITTED TO WORKING A DEAL WITH ADRIAN GASTON FOR PROBATION IN EXCHANGE FOR HIS TESTIMONY.


NO WHERE IN ANY RECORD THIS WERE/WAS STATED BECAUSE MR. DEAN, ATTORNEY E. CHARLES GROSE AND OR JUDGE ADDY WOULD HAVE ACKNOWLEDGED/OBJECTED TO SUCH STATEMENT.

THEREFORE, THE STATE, IN THIS MATTER HAS BEEN GRANTED ITS THIRTY (30) DAY EXTENTION OF TIME TO RETRIEVE THE TRANSCRIPTS SO THIS MATTER MAY PROCEED. MR. DEAN'S BOND WAS DENIED JULY 21<sup>ST</sup> 2016 BY JUDGE DONALD HOCKER PENDING APPEAL, IN WHICH THIS APPEAL IS FUTILE - ONLY TO DELAY/POSTPONE MR. DEAN'S RELEASE. DIVISIONAL SUPERVISOR - SPECIAL AGENT J. MICHAEL COLLINS OF S.L.E.D. WAS CONTACTED ON OR ABOUT AUGUST 2016, AND HE INFORMED MR. DEAN'S ASSOCIATE THAT ALL HIS PENDING CHARGES WERE VACATED AND HE'S AWAITING TO BE RELEASED. THIS S.L.E.D. AGENT WAS THE FIRST TO INVESTIGATE.

AS A RESULT OF S.L.E.D.'S INVESTIGATION, IT HAS TURNED OUT THAT D.E.U. (DRUG ENFORCEMENT UNIT) BRANDON STRICKLAND WHO DID OR HAD MULTIBLE PRIVATE / SECRET INTERVIEWS WITH ADRIAN GASTON IN REFERENCE TO THEIR ULTIMATE SCHEME TO DECIEVE THE JUDICIAL SYSTEM AGAINST MR. DEAN. FORMER D.E.U. BRANDON STRICKLAND HAS RECENTLY BEEN ARRESTED AND INDICTED FOR COMMITTING MISCONDUCT ETC. 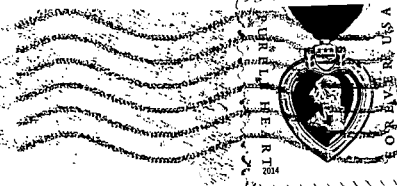
