Please accept this letter as a follow-up to my letter dated August 30, 2016. I have heard from Mark McKinnon, the public defender who represented Mr. Jordan prior to his retaining David Cook. Mr. McKinnon advised me that a Schmerber hearing took place on February 20, 2014, before the Honorable Lee Alford and that a bond hearing took place on April 3, 2014, before Judge Alford. According to Mr. McKinnon, there was a discussion of DNA evidence at both of these hearings. It is my belief that one or both of these transcripts may be what Mr. Jordan desires. As a result, and in consultation with Chief Appellate Defender Robert M. Dudek, our office is ordering the transcripts today. Please find enclosed proof of such. As soon as our office receives these transcripts, we will provide copies to Mr. Jordan and the state, and advise this Court of their receipt.
