Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your record on appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The binding does not comply with Rule 267(d), SCACR. If staples or clasps are used to bind the volumes, the spines must then be bound with heavy tape. Your records on appeal are held together with clasps, but have not been bound with heavy tape along the spine.
- The covers do not comply with Rule 267(e), SCACR. The front and back covers of the record on appeal must be of a material not less than 50 pound paper weight and not glassine. The covers on your record on appeal appear to be regular paper weight.
- The document exceeds 100 pages and therefore must be double-sided as required by Rule 267(c), SCACR.

All final briefs will be due to be served and filed within twenty days after service and filing of the corrected record on appeal.
