On November 3, 2015, this court heard a Motion for New Trial in this case. The defendant, Candice Beasley, was represented at the hearing by counsel of record, Mr. Stephen Hudson, Esquire, and the State was represented by Eleventh Circuit Assistant Solicitor Suzanne Mayes.

The defendant, Candice Beasley, was convicted of Infliction of Great Bodily Injury upon a Child and Unlawful Conduct towards a Child on August 12, 2015 pursuant to the above-referenced indictments in Lexington County General Sessions Court.
