We are sending our September 12, 2016, deficiency letter again as it was incorrectly addressed to the appellants/respondents' attorneys.

Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief of respondent/appellant and your respondent's initial brief of respondent/appellant, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected on the final briefs:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, pursuant to Rule 267(a) SCACR, the brief should contain the attorney information of the counsel submitting the document. The appellants/respondents' attorney information must not be a part of the

caption of either the appellant's final brief of respondent/appellant or the respondent's final brief of respondent/appellant.

- Please name both final briefs clearly. For example: Respondent's Final Brief of Respondent/Appellant.
