Dear Jenny Kitchings, Clerk:

I am writing in reference to my Direct Appeal and my lawyer; relieving herself from my case. The evidence of the judges use of abuse is clear. Either judge Hyman was bias or neglectful to my case.

Legal cases are contests between oppossing sides, which ensure that the evidence and legal arguments will be fully and forcefully presented. So with that being said, I have faith and believe in our law, but it is up to our elected officials to make sure that it is upheld and followed by every man and woman. When you have a jury trial the judge takes on the role as legal advisor, explaining the law to the juries. Trial judge has the responsibility for safeguarding both the rights of the accused and the interest of the public in the administration of criminal justice.

Mrs. Susan Hackett states that my 6th and 14th amendments were violated. And under the judges function book it is standard under Rule 6-1.5 (a)(b) Obligation to use court time effectively and fairly. If judge Hyman had went through the Motion of Discovery, he would have seen multiple errors. Section 14-25-55 of South Carolina Statehouse: Powers and Duties chief of police and police officers.

The chief of police of the municipality for which a court is established,

or someone designated by him, shall attend upon the sessions of the court. The chief of police and the police officers of such municipality shall be subject to the orders of the court and shall execute the orders, writs and mandates thereof and perform such other duties in connection therewith as may be prescribed by the ordinances of the municipality. The chief of police and police officers shall also be invested with the same powers and duties as are provided for magistrates' constables.

Now this applies to the judges neglect or his abuse of power. He ordered Detective Long to have Mr. Micheal Cavallini present tomorrow to take the stand, Mr. Cavallini was the primary officer in this case; supposedly watching it all unfold from the beginning. A judges standard function 6-1.5 (a)(b) Obligation to use court time effectively and fairly. By not making my accuser present and not stating why he cannot be there, it was further proof of his bias conduct.

Judge Hyman continued to violate by not keeping his composer in open court. He is supposed to be non-bias towards me yet the video security footage will clearly show; he acted very unprofessional. Hyman constantly violated the law and rules he took an oath to uphold.

The judge said that I had enough time to research and deligate my case; yet he allowed SCRCP and my due process to be broken. Judge Hyman allowed the solicitor to lie in open court, about not knowing how I was going to defend myself. How fair is that. I asked for a change of venue because of the history in the county. I was railroaded by them in January of 2004 my due process and the negotiated plea was violated back then and a judge said, "can you prove it". It's very obvious that the lower courts have major flaws. The law is what it is. It does not need the opinion of man, it needs to be taken word for word what it means. I need to be heard in my Direct Appeal, I'm doing life in prison when I should be doing 5 years for Criminal Conspiracy and 5 for felon

around a gun. The judge showed the jury false facts and didn't try to pursue the truth. I ask you how can there be justice with lies? I urge you to grant me this.

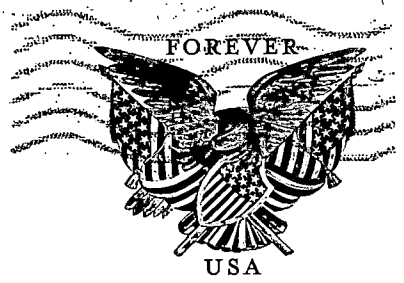
The error is not hidden, yet broadcasted throughout the trial. When you call upon me I will be ready to show you the evidence and law as it should be.
