ORDER

After careful consideration, the motion to dismiss is denied. It appears to this court that a remand for an attempt at reconstructing the record in this case is warranted. Accordingly, this case is remanded to the York County Court of Common Pleas. Counsel for Appellant is ordered to contact counsel for Respondent and the master-in-equity, the Honorable S. Jackson Kimball, within ten days of this order to schedule such hearings as the master deems appropriate. Counsel for Appellant shall provide an update to the clerk of this court no later than fifteen days from the date of this order, with a copy to counsel for Respondent. Because this case has been remanded, Appellant's request for an extension of time to serve and file Appellant's initial brief and designation of matter is moot.
