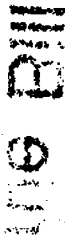

being duly sworn deposes and says that defendant George Holmes

did within this county and state on or about 4/6/2014 violate the criminal laws of the

State of South Carolina (or ordinance of County/ Municipality of Beaufort)

in the following particulars:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: Sex / Indecent exposure

I further state that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

That on April 6, 2014, at approximately 7:00pm, the defendant and Beaufort Detention Center in-mate, George Holmes, did wilfully expose his genitals to victim, Ms. Jessica Desantis, who was working in the capacity of a correctional officer and who proceeded to masturbate in front of the witness and call the victim, "a cunt, a slut, a cokehead, a dope fiend." This was witnessed by Corporal Robinson of the Beaufort County Detention Center Staff. The allegations are corroborated by security footage within the jail cell of the defendant who is captured with his back to the camera and who appears to be masturbating at various intervals. This violation occurred at 106 Ribaut Rd, which is in the City Limits of Beaufort, SC. The affiant and others can prove the same.




