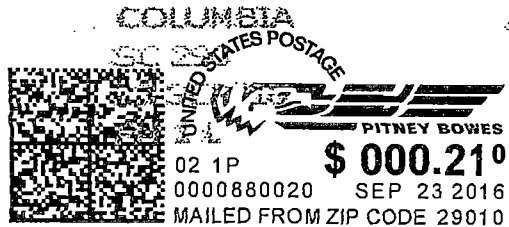
I am in need of this Extension of Time to perfect my Brief. Please inform me of the status of this issue As soon as you can.
