Upon reviewing your Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and **any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:**

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. The proof of service for any document should state the specific document that was served. In this instance, the proof of service should state service of the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix, not the Final Brief of Appellant.
- The Record on Appeal has not been paginated in accordance with Rule 210(c), SCACR. Specifically, each page of the Record on Appeal should be numbered consecutively beginning with the index.
- The Appendix does not comply with Rule 242(e)(1), SCACR. Specifically, the final briefs have not been included with the Appendix.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the cover page of the Record on Appeal and/or Appendix does not list the names, addresses and phone numbers of **all counsel in the case.**
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption for all documents should read as follows:

v.
