
Dear Counsel and Mr. Lynd:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal. The notice of appeal references two orders which must be provided to the Court.
- The document has not been timely filed. A motion to allow the late filing will have to be made and accompanied by the \$25.00 motion fee.
- Pursuant to Rule 203(e)(1)(e)(E), SCACR, the notice of appeal must contain the names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each. You must provide an amended notice of appeal correcting this deficiency.

- Pursuant to Rule 264, SCACR, you remain the attorney of record for Mr. Lynd. If you no longer wish to represent Mr. Lynd you must file the appropriate motion with this Court within 10 days.
