

This matter came before the Court for consideration of Defendant Southern Health Partners, Inc.'s motion to reconsider this Court's prior July 5, 2016 Order granting the Plaintiff's prior motions to compel. In its motion to reconsider filed on July 22, 2016, Defendant Southern Health Partners, Inc. asked that this Court revisit the portion of the July 5, 2016 Order directing Southern Health Partners, Inc. to respond to the Plaintiff's Request for Production No. 12 (seeking tax returns) and Request for Production No. 13 (seeking accounting/accountant's statements).


Southern Health Partners, Inc. filed a memorandum of law on July 22, 2016, to which the Plaintiff responded on August 15, 2016. A hearing was held on this matter on August 22, 2016, during which time the Court heard argument from counsel for Defendant Southern Health Partners, Inc. and counsel for the Plaintiff. Based upon the submissions and argument of the parties at the hearing on this matter, the Court hereby DENIES Defendant Southern Health Partners, Inc.'s motion to reconsider.

In reaching this conclusion, the Court notes the distinction between the admissibility versus the discoverability of information noted by the District Court for the Eastern District of North



Carolina in Blount v. Wake Elec. Membership Corp., 162 F.R.D. 102, 105 (E.D.N.C. 1993). The Court further notes that the information to be released will be released under the provisions of this Court's Confidentiality Order. The Court directs Southern Health Partners, Inc. to produce the materials detailed in this Court's July 5, 2016 Order within 30 days from the date of this Order.
