
ORDER

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case are due to be served and filed today, having been extended by one prior order of this Court.



Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Albert C. Smith, II v. State in the Supreme Court on April 9, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Lewis D. Williams in the Court of Appeals on March 30, 2012. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of Brian Gebhard v. State in the Court of Appeals on March 29, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Lenson Clyburn, Jr. v. State in the Supreme Court on March 26, 2012. Counsel filed petitions for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendices in the cases of Glenn Pernell v. State, Sylvester Toomer v. State and William Gladney Harden v. State in the Supreme Court on March 23, 2012. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Lewis Williams in the Court of Appeals on March 12, 2012.
