
Dear Mr. Young:

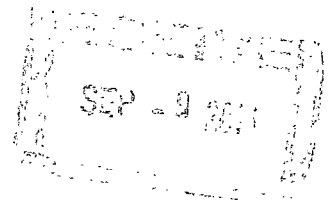



NOTICE OF APPEAL


