Motion To Recall Remittitur

On June 12, 2016, the appellants filed the Motion For Full Panel Reviews on the issue of releasing the counsel and hiring a new counsel within 30 days. Until this day, the appellant has not received an order from the full panel review.

on Aug. 11, 2016, the single judge simply issued the order to ~~dismiss~~ the appeal on the ground that "new counsel has failed to make an appearance on behalf of the appellants." Without given the appellants an opportunity for oral argument or for a full panel review of the case, this is outright prejudice ~~of~~ and discrimination.

against the appellants. The question is whether the appellant's motions have even actually been submitted for the full panel review and why?

On Aug. 17, 2016, the appellant filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the South Carolina Supreme Court, in order to protect her due process and equal protection rights. The petition was dismissed due to "no petition for rehearing or reinstatement has been acted on by the court of Appeals, Rule 242(c), SCACR." "Under Rule 242(a) of SCACR, this court will only review a final decision of the court of Appeals, and a decision is not final for the purposes of review until a petition for rehearing or reinstatement has been acted by the court of Appeals."

Therefore, the Petition for Writ of Certiorari is simply acted as an amend to the motions for oral argument and for full panel review, without disposing

these legal requests, the dismissal order of Aug. 11, 2016 and the Remittitur of Aug. 26, 2016 deprived the appellant's due process and equal protection rights. It is violation of 14th Amendment of US Constitution. The appellant hereby demands the court of Appeals to recall the remittitur and to reinstate the appeal, guaranteed by US Constitution.
