Dear Mr. Brown-Barnwell and Ms. Barnwell:

Upon reviewing your record on appeal and appellants' final brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The binding does not comply with Rule 267(d), SCACR, which states that if staples or clasps are used to bind the volumes, the spines of the volumes shall be bound with heavy tape. The record and appellants' final brief have been bound by staples. But no tape was applied. You must properly tape the spines of all 14 volumes of the record on appeal and appellants' final brief.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, it must read exactly as follows:

Nell Barnwell Hay and Edward Barnwell, Respondents,

v.

Chauncey N. Brown-Barnwell, Janice Barnwell, Bank of New York, Trust Under Agreement Dated 12/1/01 (EQCC Trust 2001-2) and all Persons claiming any right, title, estate interest in or lien upon the real estate described, and any known heirs or persons being as a class identified as John Doe, whose true names are unknown, and any unborn infants or persons under disability being a class designated as Richard Roe, whose true names are unknown, Defendants,

Of whom Chauncey N. Brown-Barnwell and Janice Barnwell are the Appellants.

The caption on the record on appeal lacks commas after Respondents and after Defendants. And the word "who" must be replaced with the word "whose" in the phrase "...whose true names..." And there needs to be a blank line after the line ending in "Respondents." You may bring stickers adequate for you to correct all volumes and the unbound volumes of the record on appeal and appellants' final brief.
