## ORDER

This notice of appeal arises out of an order of the court limiting the deposition of the appellant pursuant to the assertion of the attorney-client privilege. Because such an order is interlocutory and not directly appealable, this appeal is dismissed. *See Tucker v. Honda of S.C. Mfg., Inc.*, 354 S.C. 574, 577, 582 S.E.2d 405, 407 (2003) (noting the appellant's concern over waiver of the attorney-client privilege is not a situation in which appellate courts would abandon the policy of dismissing interlocutory appeals); *Patterson v. Spector Broadcasting Corp.*, 287 S.C. 249, 249, 335 S.E.2d 803, 803 (1985) (dismissing an appeal from an order compelling discovery). The remittitur will be sent pursuant to Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
