1 (DEFENDANT JOHN CRAWFORD, WHITE MALE, ENTERS COURTROOM  
2 FROM HOLDING CELL AT 10:43 AM.)

3 THE COURT: Mr. Crawford, how old are you?

4 MR. CRAWFORD: Fifty-one.

5 THE COURT: Are you represented by Ms. Johnson?

6 MR. CRAWFORD: Yes. Yes, sir.

7 THE COURT: I have in front of me a probation matter.  
8 It looks like you were arrested on a probation warrant on  
9 April 21st of this year. Is that correct?

10 MR. CRAWFORD: Yes, sir.

11 THE COURT: It alleges that you violated a sentence  
12 that Judge Nettles imposed on October 17th, 2012 for  
13 burglary violent, second degree. He gave you fifteen years  
14 and you served four and then you were on probation for  
15 three years; is that correct?

16 MR. CRAWFORD: Yes, sir.

17 THE COURT: The violation alleged in the affidavit on  
18 the warrant is that you had failed to follow your agents  
19 advice and instructions; that you had not reported since  
20 October 19th of last year; that you were arrested by Mount  
21 Pleasant police November 11th of last year for assault and  
22 battery first degree.

23 What's happened to that charge?

24 MS. JOHNSON: He accepted a plea, your Honor, but it  
25 was reduced to a A and B second degree charge and he is on

1 probation.

2 THE COURT: But that is a substantial violation of  
3 your current probationary sentence. How long has got  
4 probation down there in Charleston County?

5 MR. CRAWFORD: Two years, sir.

6 THE COURT: Ms. Johnson.

7 MS. JOHNSON: Thank you, your Honor. As Mr. Crawford  
8 stated he is fifty-one years of age; he is not married. He  
9 has four children, your Honor. The youngest is three years  
10 old. The others are above the age of majority. He went  
11 -- graduated high school and attended York Tech. He does  
12 yard work, your Honor, and has done yard work in the past.  
13 He was trying to build a little bit of a business there.  
14 He takes care of his mother, your Honor, who is here in the  
15 courtroom along with his aunt. His mother has had two  
16 strokes and she depends on him to be there for her and help  
17 her out.

18 I've had an opportunity to go over the allegations  
19 with him, your Honor. On the failure to report, last  
20 reporting on October 19, he tells me that he was reporting  
21 every two months so his next report would have been in  
22 December, on December 19th, your Honor. He does admit that  
23 he was arrested on the A and B first. And as I stated he  
24 did enter a plea to a A and B second degree charge, your  
25 Honor, for two years of probation.

1           The supervision fees he admits to those as well. He  
2 is hoping that at some point, there's a home that he's  
3 hoping to get some equity out of in order to get his fines  
4 and fees caught up, your Honor. I've had an opportunity to  
5 speak with Agent Sellers in reference to this and Agent  
6 Sellers' recommendation did change. He is willing to  
7 consider a ninety day revocation, your Honor, and continue  
8 him on probation. There is some restitution that is still  
9 owed and I've spoken to Mr. Crawford about that. He would  
10 like to do his time over at the prison farm.

11           There is a potential, your Honor, that his probation  
12 could potentially be transferred to Charleston. I've  
13 spoken to him about that and he really would like to stay  
14 in the county with his mother so that he can fulfill the  
15 promise he made to his father. Before his father died he  
16 was to take care of his mother. So we are asking your  
17 Honor to go along with the recommendation of ninety days  
18 and continue on probation.

19           THE COURT: Its not reflected on the affidavit on the  
20 arrest warrant.

21           MS. JOHNSON: I'm sorry.

22           THE COURT: The arrest warrant was issued February of  
23 last year so obviously he hadn't reported. It was not  
24 reflected on that that he also had some other charges from  
25 August of last year here in York County.

1 I'll be glad to hear from you, Mr. Crawford. It looks  
2 like in looking at your record that you're serving a life  
3 sentence on the installment plan. How many times you been  
4 in jail?

5 MR. CRAWFORD: Maybe four, sir.

6 THE COURT: I'll be glad to hear anything you have to  
7 say.

8 MR. CRAWFORD: I just ask that you go along with the  
9 recommendation of my parole officer and my attorney, sir,  
10 so I can be home with my family.

11 THE COURT: Well, I think it's time we'll have to give  
12 up on you because you just -- I mean when you're not in  
13 jail you're committing crimes. So I'm gonna revoke -- I'm  
14 gonna revoke your sentence and let you - You haven't -- It  
15 looks like you've never served this much time before but  
16 I'm gonna revoke your sentence and let you serve your time.

17 Thank you.

18 MS. JOHNSON: Your Honor, can I ask you to reconsider  
19 it and do a partial? Not the whole time but --

20 THE COURT: Well, not based on his record.
