
Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I received an Order yesterday, September 30, 2016, which states that my appeal should have been "made to the circuit court in the county where the principal place of practice of the attorney is located."

As I am *pro se*, my interpretation of the rules for filing an appeal indicated that I needed to send the information to both courts. In order to ensure compliance of the time-sensitive filing, and based on an abundance of caution, I sent the Appeal information to both the South Carolina Court of Appeals AND to the Court of Common Pleas 16th Circuit on September 19, 2016. 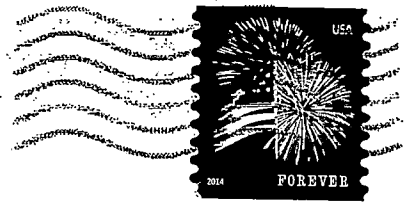
