This appeal is from an order of the circuit court granting the respondent's motion to quash and for a protective order preventing the appellant from deposing the respondent. This appeal is interlocutory pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. § 14-3-330 (1976 & Supp. 2015). *See Ex parte Wilson*, 367 S.C. 7, 13-14, 625 S.E.2d 205, 208 (2005) (concluding an order quashing a subpoena issued to a nonparty prior to the commencement or enforcement of a judgment is interlocutory and not immediately appealable). Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent pursuant to Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
