
Dear Ms. Kitchings:

Out of an abundance of caution, I write pursuant to Rule 208(b)(7), SCACR, concerning Carolina First Bank v. BADD, L.L.C., 414 S.C. 289, 778 S.E.2d 106 (2015), since the Supreme Court, after the briefs were written in this case, dismissed BADD's petition for rehearing. This concerns argument set forth on pages 20-21 of the final appellants' brief and pages 9-14 of the final reply brief. Appellants maintain that, despite the problems we see in the BADD analysis, at least some and perhaps all of the counterclaims pled by the appellants are compulsory even under that analysis.
