

ORDER

This appeal was dismissed due to Appellant's failure to cure several deficiencies noted in his record on appeal. Appellant has now filed a petition to reinstate. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall cure the deficiencies noted in this court's June 29, 2016 letter. Specifically, Appellant must (1) provide page numbers on the bottom of each page of the record on appeal; (2) include attorney information for Respondent's attorney on the cover; (3) provide the correct number of copies of the record or file a motion to reduce the number of copies required; and (4) provide the required certificate of counsel. This court will act on Appellant's petition to reinstate upon receipt of the deficiency corrections or the expiration of thirty days.
