## ORDER

After careful consideration of the motion to strike, the request to strike the three letters is granted. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR (providing that only matters presented to the lower court may be included in the record on appeal). As to the two photographs, Appellant must amend the designation of matter to "clearly identify" the photographs in order for Respondent and this court to identify how the photographs were presented to the lower court. Within ten days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file the amended designation of matter that omits the three letters and more specifically identifies the two photographs.
