
Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal does not indicate the date of the order you are appealing. Specifically, you have included documents from your previously remitted case 2015-002412.
- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- The proof of service accompanying the notice of appeal is deficient. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, you must provide the names of the parties that have been served, as well as an address for each party.
- You are requested to serve and file an amended notice of appeal that clearly identifies each respondent and the attorney representing them. All parties

are advised that service of the amended notice of appeal does not affect the timelines for the appeal.

- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$100.00.
