The undersigned counsel respectfully requests a thirty day extension in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the above-referenced case. In support of this motion, counsel would respectfully show the Court the following extraordinary circumstances:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.



Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Timothy Groves Oxendine with the Court of Appeals on September 14, 2016. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Corey Jamal Williams before the Court of Appeals on September 8, 2016. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Jimmy Turner before the Court of Appeals on September 7, 2016. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Dennis F. Sanders v. State with the Supreme Court on September 6, 2016. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Jeramy Parks with the Court of Appeals on August 24, 2016. Counsel filed the reply brief of petitioner in the case of Randall S. Tyler v. State in the Supreme Court on August 18, 2016. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Filiberto Campos with the Court of Appeals on August 17, 2016.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. As indicated by the consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


