MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for King Chevais Conyers respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until November 16, 2016**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fifth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel four previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Leonard Jenkins respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. **Counsel is being**

treated for a chronic health condition which has severely limited his working hours. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Dominique Lavar Williams before the Court of Appeals on October 12, 2016. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Rodney M. Alexander with this Court on September 30, 2016. On September 22, 2016, counsel argued motions before the PCR court in Spartanburg, South Carolina, pursuant to the Supreme Court's remand Order in the death penalty case of Marion Alexander Lindsay v. State. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Martin Rodriguez with this Court on September 19, 2016. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Timothy Groves Oxendine with this Court on September 14, 2016. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Corey Jamal Williams before this Court on September 8, 2016. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Jimmy Turner before this Court on September 7, 2016. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Dennis F. Sanders v. State with the Supreme Court on September 6, 2016. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Jeramy Parks with this Court on August 24, 2016. Counsel filed the reply brief of petitioner in the case of Randall S. Tyler v. State in the Supreme Court on August 18, 2016. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Filiberto Campos with this Court on August 17, 2016. Counsel filed a petition for rehearing in the case of Darrell L. Goss v. State with this Court on August 10, 2016.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.






