MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for appellant respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days, **until November 16, 2016**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for appellant respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously

granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Jacqueline Mesidor with the Court of Appeals on September 30, 2016. Counsel filed the motion to hold appeal in abeyance and motion to remand for reconstruction of the record in the case of The State v. Terry MacCall with the Court of Appeals on September 30, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Tommy McKnight v. The State of South Carolina in the Supreme Court on September 28, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Antwine Matthews v. The State of South Carolina in the Supreme Court on September 26, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Bernardo Evans v. The State of South Carolina in the Supreme Court on September 26, 2016. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Donte Samar Brown in the Court of Appeals on September 21, 2016. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Paula Reed Rose with the Court of Appeals on September 14, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Dennis F. Sanders v. The State of South Carolina in the Supreme Court on September 6, 2016.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension, **until November 16, 2016**, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and


designation of matter in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the brief be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
