This responds to your *pro se* request for an extension to serve and file a petition for a writ of certiorari to review the opinion of the South Carolina Court of Appeals in this case.¹

I remind your counsel before the Court of Appeals, Ginger D. Goforth, Esquire, and Duanne Alan Lazenby, Esquire, that they remain your counsel of record before this Court under Rule 264(a), SCACR. Therefore, any request for an extension will need to be filed by your counsel. *Miller v. State*, 388 S.C. 347, 697 S.E.2d 527 (2010); *Jones v. State*, 348 S.C. 13, 558 S.E.2d 517 (2002); *State v. Stuckey*, 333 S.C. 56, 508 S.E.2d 564 (1998); *Foster v. State*, 298 S.C. 306, 379 S.E.2d 907 (1989).

To give your counsel the opportunity to make a motion for an extension (which should include the filing fee required by Rule 240(d), SCACR, which was not
