REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE THE RECORD ON APPEAL  
AND FINAL BRIEF

---

Appellant Janice Cross respectfully requests an extension of time for filing the Record on Appeal in the above-captioned matter through November 30, 2012, for two important reasons.

1. The current delay is due in-part to the fact that Appellant still lacks the \$500 or so that she needs in order to pay for the required 15-20 copies that she must produce in order to serve the Court and the Respondent(s) who filed a Reply Brief in the matter, while retaining those copies necessary for her own use.

Although Appellant did have the funds available at one point, she has had to utilize the funds out of necessity in order to pay her rent and keep a roof over her head throughout this current ordeal. Still, Appellant has reason to expect to have the funds available to pay for the production of the Record on Appeal by November 30, 2012.

2. A second reason the extension is needed is that Appellant learned recently from front desk personnel at the Court of Appeals that her Record on Appeal is in error wherein it contains two transcripts consisting of 36 pages total that are in the wrong format that the Court will consider.

In an effort to save space, Appellant had unknowingly utilized the "Condensed Transcript" format for two of the transcripts that appear in her Record on Appeal. Appellant was informed that the Condensed Transcripts would be rejected by the Court. If these two transcripts are included complete, they would take up approximately 108 additional pages and would increase the 500-page limit for a single-volume Record on Appeal. At present, a second volume would make the cost of production prohibitive.

Appellant sincerely apologizes for this delay, and needs more time to select those pages from the various transcripts that are essential to her brief, and to truncate the rest in keeping within the 500-page maximum for one volume and in keeping with her current budget for production. She needs time to pare down the transcript pages so that they fit into a single volume.

Appellant fully expects to have the necessary funds in hand by November 30, 2012 to produce the Record on Appeal. Appellant feels badly for this delay, and begs the Court's indulgence in granting this much needed request for an additional extension of time.

Appellant's case is worthy of the Court's consideration of the substantive Issues on Appeal as they appear in her Amended Initial Brief.

Appellant is well aware that the FINAL BRIEF must match her AMENDED INITIAL BRIEF, and is already at the page limit for the FINAL BRIEF, which must be re-paginated to fit the page number changes in the Record on Appeal.

Appellant sincerely apologizes if this request causes any inconvenience.


