
As grounds for this Motion, the Claimant alleges and would show the Commissioner the following:

1. That Appellant filed a Notice of Appeal with the Appellate Court on September 15, 2016.
2. That attached to the Notice of Appeal was a South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission Judicial Conference Decision and Order dated August 15, 2016 which showed the case was dismissed as Interlocutory.

3. That on or about September 28, 2016, Appellant's attorney received a letter dated September 21, 2016 advising that the Notice of Appeal had to be accompanied by a complete Order challenged on Appeal and the same was required in order to move the Appeal forward in normal protocol.
4. That on September 28, 2016, Appellant's attorney wrote the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission (SCWCC) advising the Appellate Court is requesting a Full Appellate Panel Decision Order indicating the complete case caption with all the Commissioners' signatures.
5. That also on September 28, 2016, SCWCC sent an email advising Appellant's attorney that the Interlocutory Order is just a one piece of paper dismissing the SCWCC appeal.
6. Then on October 14, 2016 it became clear to Appellant that no complete Order could be acquired, therefore, resulting in Appellant being completely out of the timeline protocol for obtaining the transcript of the original proceeding.
7. Consequently, Appellant through its attorney now requests the Transcript be ordered out of time.

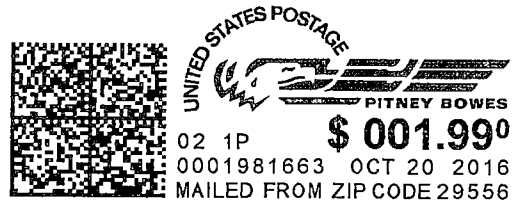
