Dear Mr. Kinlaw:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal is deficient. You only included proofs of service with your filings. You must serve and file an amended notice of appeal substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. All parties are advised that service of the amended notice of appeal does not affect the timelines for the appeal.
- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- The proof of service accompanying the notice of appeal is deficient. You included 3 proofs of service with your filings. Your documents indicate that you served Brian O'Keefe and Erin Hantske. They are not listed as parties to this appeal. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.

- The notice of appeal does not indicate the date of the order you are appealing.
- Your money order numbered 23540394126 for \$150.00 is being returned to you. The correct filing fee of \$100.00 must be submitted.
