

On October 14, 2016, Jerry Mandell Simpson entered a guilty plea on each of the above referenced Indictments before the Honorable J. Derham Cole. The plea was a negotiated plea and Judge Cole accepted the negotiations and sentenced Mr. Simpson to twelve (12) years on one Indictment and thirty (30) years suspended to 5 years probation, consecutive, on the second Indictment. Also, pursuant to the negotiations, Judge Cole ran these sentences concurrent to a federal supervised released revocation and gave him credit for the time he had spent in jail and on electronic monitoring.

Mr. Simpson is now unhappy with the sentence he received and has directed me to file an appeal on his behalf. There have been no post-trial issues raised, therefore, there have been no lower court rulings after Mr. Simpson's plea.
