¹ It appears Appellant is attempting to appeal the circuit court's denial of Appellant's petition to proceed *in forma pauperis*. This court notes that if Appellant files a certified copy of his trust account with the circuit court and it shows Appellant has insufficient funds to pay the filing fee, Appellant will be entitled to file his action and make payments in accordance with section 24-27-100 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (2007). This court's file does not indicate whether Appellant has filed the certified copy of his trust account with the circuit court or whether the circuit court previously considered this matter.

² Because this appeal is dismissed, this court declines to act on Appellant's pending motions.
